Residents celebrate National Trails Day

Anchorage's first system of sustainable single track trails for mountain biking will be formally opened with a ribbon cutting, beginning at 9 a.m. Saturday, June 6, at Hilltop Ski Area South Parking Lot. Acting Mayor Matt Claman will join the Parks & Recreation Department and partner organizations for the event and related volunteer projects inaugurating new Far North Bicentennial Park (FNBP) single track trails in celebration of National Trails Day.

Volunteers will work on trail projects in FNBP between 9:15 a.m. and 12 p.m., culminating in a pizza party at the Campbell Creek Science Center.

"National Trails Day is part of our ongoing efforts to get kids and families outdoors and active," Claman said. "In Anchorage, we're fortunate to have access to more than 11,000 acres of parkland and excellent connections to Chugach State Park. These new trails will provide more healthy outdoor recreation opportunities for the Anchorage community."

National Trails Day is a celebration of trails and public lands, inspiring Americans to get outdoors and discover their local trails and volunteer in trail projects. The Anchorage community will recognize National Trails Day with a variety of volunteer projects improving trails in parks throughout the area, including several projects in FNBP.

Singletrack Advocates partnered with the Parks & Recreation Department and several community organizations to construct new trail segments, which comprise Anchorage's

first system of sustainable, soft-surface, narrow trails. Youth Employment in Parks crews worked on the project last summer, learning sustainable trail-building techniques in the process.

"We appreciate this opportunity to work with the Municipality, state and federal agencies and community groups to improve mountain biking opportunities in Anchorage," Singletrack Advocates member Janice Tower said. "We look forward to a summer of trail enjoyment!"
