

2 PROPOSITION

PARK PROJECTS CITY WIDE

Proposition 2 will protect and maintain water quality in local creeks and streams, improve and maintain parks and trails, provide for playground and family recreation areas and enhance and preserve natural areas and open space.

Cost: \$2.52 per \$100,000 of assessed property value.

3 PROPOSITION

EAST ANCHORAGE

Proposition 3 will allow the Municipality Of Anchorage to enter into a long-term, non-exclusive lease of the golf course facility at Russian Jack Springs Park with Russian Jack Springs Jr. Golf Association—a non-profit organization. The golf association would upgrade and maintain public golf facilities for youth programs and provide exercise and educational programs through the game of golf. Russian Jack Park would remain a community park for year-round family and sports activities including Nordic skiing, bicycling, picnicking, hiking.

Cost: There is no cost to taxpayers and no increase in property taxes as a result of the lease.

4 PROPOSITION

SOUTH ANCHORAGE

Proposition 4 will allow a land trade to expand the existing South Anchorage Park. This would include the development of a year-round multi-use community park on the Klatt Homestead.

Cost: The taxpayers of the Municipality do not incur an increase in property taxes as a result of the land trade.

5 PROPOSITION

EAGLE RIVER

Proposition 5 will allow for a land trade to prove a trail-head parking lot and trail corridor to Mount Baldy, located adjacent to Chugach State Park in Eagle River.

Cost: The taxpayers of the Municipality do not incur an increase in property taxes as a result of the land trade.
